Local architect Henry Hammer is working with Larry Grimes and Les Bowker to prepare a preliminary site plan for the Elfin Forest. Come to our meeting and offer your input on how you would like to see us save the Elfin Forest for the future!

PCL Bond Initiative The Planning and Conservation League is putting together a ballot initiative for a bond act for forest land acquisition (this is not Governor Wilson's Environmental Bond Act.) San Luis Obispo County Parks has submitted as a line item a request for \$1.5 million toward the purchase of the Elfin Forest. We will need your help collecting signatures on a petition to place this bond act on the 1992 ballot. This could be a very significant step toward realizing our goal of saving the Elfin Forest!


